06.600 Academic Workload Requirements

06.601 <u>Faculty Academic Workload Policy</u>. The Board recognizes

that teaching, research, creative activity, and professional service are important elements of faculty academic workloads. Each General Academic Institution shall adopt an academic workload policy that gives appropriate weight to each of these activities when determining the standards for faculty academic workload, gives appropriate weight to other activities recognized by the Institution as important elements, and assigns responsibility for determining workloads that meet these requirements. Each General Academic Institution shall report its policy to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and include the

policy in its operating budget.

06.602 <u>Compliance Report to the Board.</u> Within 30 days of the end

of each academic year, each General Academic Institution shall file with the Board a report that complies with the

requirements of Texas Education Code § 51.402(c).

06.603 <u>Academic Workload Officer</u>. The President of each

General Academic Institution shall designate a person who will monitor workloads, prepare and review appropriate workload reports, and submit the reports as required by this

Regents Rule and Texas Education Code § 51.402(c).
