## 07.400 Tuition and Fees

O7.401 Policy on Tuition and Fees. Each Institution shall adopt policies on student tuition and fees that comply with federal and state law, these Regents Rules, and relevant Board Orders and shall publish tuition and fee information in accordance with Regents Rule 07.111.

## 07.402 Tuition.

- 1. <u>Authority to Set Tuition</u>. The Board has the authority to and shall set tuition rates for each Institution in accordance with Texas Education Code § 54.008 and other applicable federal and state laws.
- 2. <u>Delegation of Authority to Waive Tuition</u>. The Board delegates to each President the authority to waive tuition to the extent that the Board is required to or may waive tuition pursuant to Chapter 54 of the Texas Education Code.
- 3. <u>Delegation of Authority to Collect Tuition</u>. The Board delegates to each President the authority to collect the payment of tuition in accordance with those methods prescribed or authorized by statute.

## 07.403 Fees.

- 1. <u>Authority to Set Fees</u>. The Board has the authority to and shall set the following fees:
  - a. <u>Student Services Fees</u>. After considering recommendations by the President related to the student fee budget, the Board shall set student services fees for each Institution as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.503. A student fee advisory committee shall be established at each Institution in accordance with Texas Education Code § 54.5031. As allowed by Texas Education

- Code § 54.5031(g), the student fee committee shall make recommendations to the President related to the student fee budget and may appear before the Board to address differences in its recommendations and the President's recommendations.
- b. <u>Medical Services Fee</u>. The Board may charge students registered at each Institution a medical services fee as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.5081.
- c. <u>Student Recreational Facility Fee.</u> If approved by a student vote in accordance with the requirements of Texas Education Code § 54.5091(a), the Board may charge each student enrolled at UNT a student recreational facility fee as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.5091.
- d. <u>International Education Fee</u>. The Board may charge students enrolled at each Institution an international education fee as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.5132.
- e. Washington, D.C. Internship Education Fee. The Board may charge students enrolled at each Institution a Washington, D.C. internship education fee as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.5134.
- f. Student Union Fee. The Board may charge students enrolled at UNT a student union fee as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.519. The Board may charge students enrolled at Institutions other than UNT a student union fee as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.515.
- g. Other Fees and Charges. The Board may charge students enrolled at each Institution such other fees and charges as permitted by Chapter 54 and Chapter 55 of the Texas Education Code.

- 2. <u>Delegation of Authority to Set Certain Fees</u>. The Board delegates to each President the authority to set the following fees:
  - a. <u>Laboratory Fees</u>. The President of each Institution may set laboratory fees as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.501.
  - b. <u>Charges and Fees for Certain Payments</u>. The President of each Institution may set charges and fees for certain payments as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.5011.
  - c. General Property Deposits. The President of each Institution may charge a general property deposit in accordance with Texas Education Code § 54.502. Such funds shall be maintained, invested, and refunded in accordance with Texas Education Code §§ 54.502-.5022.
  - d. <u>Incidental Fees</u>. The President of each Institution may fix the rate of "incidental fees" to be paid by students and prospective students and may make rules for the collection of the fees and distribution of funds as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.504. The Institution shall publish in the student catalog a description of the amount of each fee charged.
  - e. <u>Vehicle, Parking, and Traffic Fees</u>. The President of each Institution may charge fees related to vehicles, parking, and traffic as permitted by Texas Education Code § 54.505.
- 3. <u>Delegation of Authority to Prorate Fees</u>. The Board delegates to each President the authority to prorate the amount of any fee charged to a student under Chapter 54 of the Texas Education Code based on the length of the semester or term for which a student is enrolled.

- 4. <u>Delegation of Authority to Waive Fees</u>. The Board delegates to each President the authority to waive any fee the Board is required to waive or may waive pursuant to Chapter 54 of the Texas Education Code.
- 5. <u>Delegation of Authority to Collect Fees</u>. The Board delegates to each President the authority to collect the payment of fees in accordance with those methods prescribed or authorized by statute.
