PROCESS UPDATE:

Direct Deposit is Now Easier to Update and More Secure

As part of the UNT System's ongoing effort to improve processes and serve its team members, we are excited to launch a convenient and secure self-service function for faculty and staff to update their direct deposit information. This new, self-service feature for updating your direct deposit information is available immediately and utilizes multifactor authentication (MFA) to help eliminate cyber threats and ensure that our team members' personal information remains private.

In order to use this new self-service feature, simply enroll in Duo multifactor authentication online at <https://mfa.untsystem.edu>. Once securely enrolled, you will be able to update your direct deposit information in EIS.
